

Red Hook Greenway and Trails Committee Minutes
January 25, 2022, 6:30 PM via Zoom

1. The Town's Local Waterfront Revitalization Plan Committee requested the Committee's input for an updated plan. Designated area extends from the river to just east of 9G between the boundaries with Rhinebeck and Columbia County. Long-term ideas can be included, which can enhance access to various state grants. Suggestions can be sent to Lisa or Brenda to be passed along to the LWRPC. Potential of working with Jenrette Property's trust (Classical American Homes Preservation Trust) and Unification property owner was discussed.
2. Regarding meeting times for 2022, Lisa will send out a doodle poll to determine the best day/week.
3. Updates:
 - Aspinwall bridge replacement will interrupt V2V; will reach out to Highway Department to determine timeline; potential detours include "Ghost" trail through Winnakee property and/or on-road route Linden to Whalesback.
 - The Traditions developer is installing Hucklebush signage (design to include RH Trails branding and was approved by Committee)
 - Brenda and Lisa walked potential Sawkill Trail "spur" with Warren Rosenthal (Winnakee) that will loop from Sawkill overlook to east/west trail close to intersection with Fir Street extension entrance.
 - As a follow up to meeting with NYSDOT in January, Lisa sent request to DOT local rep re two V2V concerns: to consider limiting right turns on red at 9G/Kelly Road intersection and to add sharrows to Route 199 (West Market Street) between Linden Avenue and Church Street.
 - Brenda and Lisa will start work in earnest with designer to produce consistent and updatable trail maps/QR codes for use on printed/kiosk/online resources.
